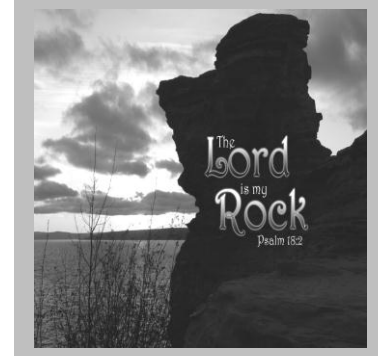
It seems as though every day we pick up a newspaper only to find story after story after story of horrific tales and fear inflicting information.
