Life on the Rock

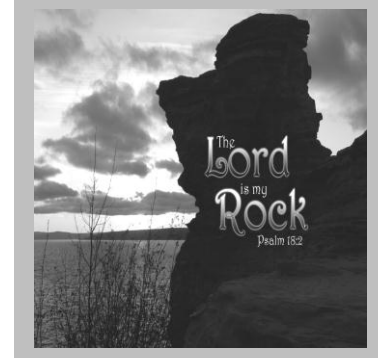

- The Walleye's eyes are so sensitive to light that they are likely to go deep into the lake on a sunny day

MN Fishing Tips

- Rather than dealing with messy worm bedding, take several healthy night crawlers and put them in a bucket of ice. The ice water melts and washes off the bedding and the worms stay cold and healthy. At the end of the day, put the unused worms back into the bedding.
- If the wind is blowing hard-the walleye will be biting in the area of the larger waves.
- Fishing is very slow after a cold front moves in. It is best to wait for the weather to stabilize for 48-72 hours, and then go fishing.
